WILLIAM H. BARTLETT, 87, of Eustis, Florida,

died Saturday, January 9, 2010 at his home in Eustis.

He was born March 8, 1922 in Cumberland, Maryland

to Florida in August of 1990 from Fairfax

County, Virginia. Mr. Bartlett enlisted in

the US Navy in December of 1941. He

and the Navy Reserves for 39 years, retiring

in March of 1982 with the rank of Commander.

Mr. Bartlett is a graduate of Drury College

of Springfield, Missouri and Virginia Tech

of Blacksburg, Virginia. He taught History,

Government and Economics at Annandale and

McLean High Schools in the Fairfax County,

Virginia public schools for almost 20 years.

Methodist Church, Leesburg, FL; a member of

The Olive Branch Chapter of the Masonic Lodge

in Leesburg, Virginia; a member of the

Military Officers Association and the

American Legion. While living in the Washington

area, (Fairfax County, Virginia) he was a

member of the National Presbyterian

Church in Washington, D.C. where he served

as an Elder and a member of The Session.

Mr. Bartlett is survived by his wife of 67 Years,

Mary Ellen; two sons, William and Gregory;

four grandchildren and four great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by one son, John Robert.
