William Twining Chadwick February 25, 1916-August 31, 2010 William Twining Chadwick, 94 of Eustis, FL died at Florida Waterman Hospital with family and friends close by. Bill was born in Monroe, WI, the son of Howard and Phoebe {Twining} Chadwick. Bill graduated from the University of Wisconsin in 1938 and always remained loyal to the Wisconsin Badgers and the Green Bay Packers. After graduation Bill worked for Weyerhaeuser Lumber in southern Wisconsin and Illinois. He enlisted in the Army Air Corps in 1941 and worked in the Meteorological branch in England and France. He was married to Louise Murdock in Biloxi, MS in 1941. The family settled in Billings, Montana following the war. In 1952 he became the manager for the new branch of Carl Weissman & Sons. Bill took great joy in helping people and providing innovative solutions for his customers. Bill was an enthusiast golfer. He enjoyed building a boat, a cabin and cherished time with family and friends. His wife Louise passed away in 1977 and he married Marjorie Doss in 1979. Following retirement they moved to Florida where Bill was an active member of the Unitarian Church. Bill is survived by his children: William Chadwick {Chad} of Billings, and Molly {William} Walton of Janesville, WI, 3 grandsons Christian {Melanie} Walton {children Cadell and Vivienne}, Ian and Alex Walton. He is further survived by his stepchildren Claudia {Doss} Carlson, Marsha {Doss} Monahan, David Doss and their families. He was preceded in
