William Robert Chouinard Sr., 88, passed away on Friday, June 26, 2015, in Leesburg, Virginia after a lengthy illness. Bob was born December 21, 1926 in Lewiston, Maine. The oldest of four children, he joined the U.S. Navy in 1943 and served for eight years through WWII and the Korean conflict. Bob personally experienced two atomic bomb tests at Bikini Atoll while serving on the USS Fall River. After leaving the Navy, he joined the Federal Aviation Administration where he served as an air traffic controller and supervisor at Portland, Maine Air Traffic Control Tower for over 30 years.

Bob and Irene lived in Auburn, Maine where Bob was an avid golfer and a member at Fairlawn Country Club. Once retired, they moved to The Villages, Florida where they lived for 20 years. While at The Villages, they played a lot of golf and enjoyed the company of many friends.

Bob was predeceased by his beloved wife of 64 years, Irene, his sister Dot, and his two brothers Arthur and Paul. Bob is survived by his only son; William (Bill) Jr, daughter-in-law; Nancee, grandson; William III and his wife Michelle, granddaughter; Marcee, and three great grandchildren.
