### Obituary of William Coleman

William Thomas Coleman, Jr, 90, of Indian Harbour Beach, FL, died Wednesday, July 9, 2014 at Ocala, FL. He was born July 27, 1923 in Bushnell, FL. Mr. Coleman was a Colonel in the United States Air Force and a WWII Veteran where he flew P38s in combat in the Pacific Theatre in defense of our nation. He was a lifetime member of the "Headhunters" 80th Fighter Squadron, the Order of the Daedalians for commissioned flight officers and military pilots, the Military Officer's Association, the UF Alumni Association, Calvary Chapel of Melbourne, a past member of the Screen Actors Guild, past member of the Gideons, and actively supported Police Family Survivors & the Wounded Warriors Funds along with St. Jude's Hospital and Smile Project.

He is survived by his son, William Thomas (Beth) Coleman, III of Ocala, FL; daughter, Karin (Scott) Lee of Kissimmee, FL; and three grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Dorothy Giddens Coleman; and brother, Rev. Richard "Dick" Coleman.
