



William "Bill" Lambert

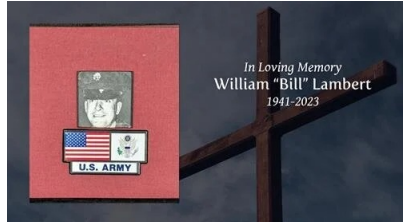
June 12, 1941 - December 1, 2023
