### Obituary of William Muirhead

William "Bill" R. Muirhead passed away Friday, January 25, 2013 at 89 years of age. Bill was born in Newark, N.J. in March 1923. He served his country with distinction during WWII receiving several honors including two bronze stars, good conduct medal and the French National Legion Medal of Honor. Upon returning from Europe, he attended Rutgers University where he majored in business. He worked for Standard Register as a sales executive. Bill and Carolyn moved to the Villages in 1997 from Carmel, IN. Bill loved to play golf and enjoyed gardening, achieving Master Gardener while he lived in Carmel, IN. He was also an avid swimmer, bridge-player and bird-watcher. He and his wife, Carolyn, enjoyed many excursions abroad. Besides his family, Bill's greatest love was God and the Bible. He started attending bible fellowships in Indiana held by The Way International in 1971 and continued to attend meetings held in Winter Garden after moving to Florida. He touched many lives by faithfully sending out via email a "Daily Promise."

Survivors include his wife Carolyn, daughters Lorraine Low and Louise (Lee) Patch, and grand-children, Amanda Grace (Ben) Breedlove, Robert Low, Ella Patch and Will Patch.
