Obituary of William Rutecki

William "Bill" Henry Rutecki, age 82, of The Villages, FL died Tuesday, May 6th, 2014, surrounded by his loving family and pastor. He was born February 21st, 1932 in Philadelphia, PA. He moved to The Villages 11 years ago from Clarks Summit, PA and was a member of Village of Faith Baptist Church.

Bill was previously employed as an Engineer at Chamberlain Corporation in Scranton, PA. He was a veteran of the United States Navy during the Korean War and earned several medals and letters of commendation for his service. A man of great faith, he was dedicated to studying and teaching the Bible and also wrote extensively on Biblical theology.

Bill was survived by his wife, Natalie H. Rutecki of The Villages, FL; sons William J. Rutecki of Hanover, MD; Richard A.
