### Obituary of William Weidner

William "Bill" Owen Weidner, of Sheffield, PA passed away in his winter home on April 7 in Wildwood, FL after a final struggle with Parkinson's Disease. He was 74 years old.

William was born June 5, 1941 in Kane, PA to William and Nora Weidner. He married Gayle Silves on May 15, 1965. William was a proud Vietnam Veteran who served in the United States Army, 4th Infantry Division. After returning from Vietnam he earned a bachelor's and master's degree from Edinboro University and St. Bonaventure University respectively. He loved his country and his home town of Sheffield, PA and was an active member of the Sheffield VFW, sports boosters, his church, and the Masons.

William is survived by his wife Gayle Weidner of Sheffield, PA; his son Erich Weidner of Round Rock, TX; his daughter Nora DeVries of Sheffield, PA; and his grandchildren Cody, Cole, and Cutter DeVries. He is preceded in death by his parents William and Nora Weidner; his brothers, Clarence Porter of Tionesta, PA; and Herman Weidner of Sheffield, PA.
