Wilma Elizabeth (Isenberger) Schultz, 90, of 800 Lake Port Blvd. Leesburg, Florida died Sunday, May 3, 2015. Born in Clarion, Iowa on April 10, 1925, she earned a B.S. and Ph.D. from the University of Iowa and a M.S. from Illinois State Normal - all in Physical Education. She was a teacher and professor at a variety of universities before becoming Chair and Head of the Department of Women's Education at the University of Wisconsin, Oshkosh. She married Frank C. W.
